ity. We were at Rita's, a medium sized joint located in old town that attracts lots of people on the weekends with its busy atmosphere and flavorful food.

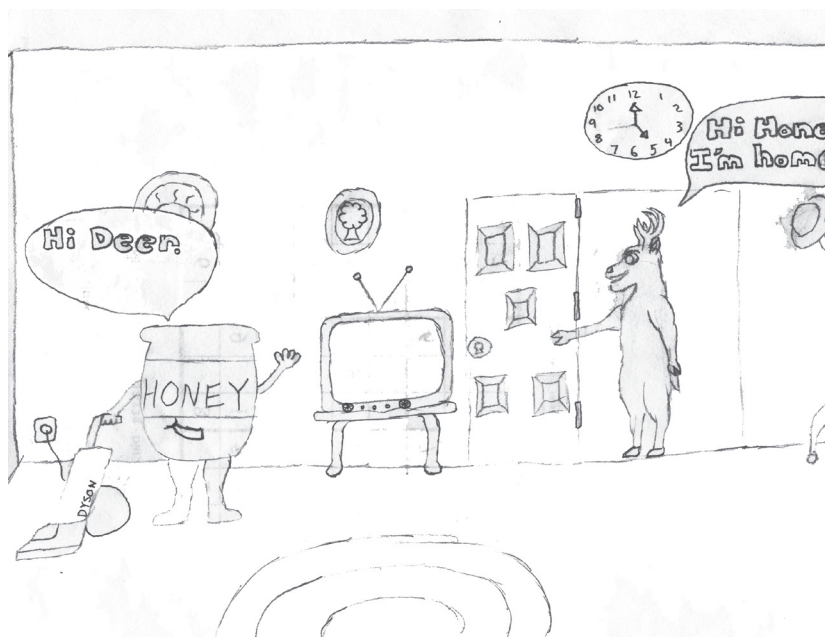

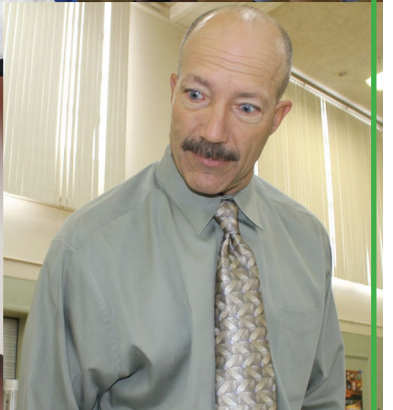
