Establishment of Student Scholarship Program:

BY LAWS:

Redwood Council 3103 Eel River Valley, of the Knights of Columbus does hereby establish a Student Scholarship Program (SSP). It is the intent of the Redwood Council 3103 that two \$1,000 scholarships be awarded each year.

1. Eligibility Requirements for SSP Applicants:

- a. The Applicant must be in their Senior year.
- b. The application packet must be complete and returned by the stated date on the application.
- c. The applicant must be in good academic and behavioral standing with their current school.
- d. Must be a practicing member of the Roman Catholic Church
- e. Must be a resident of the Eel River Valley area.
 - i. Redwood Valley area includes Garberville, Scotia, Rio Dell, Fortuna, Loleta, Hydesville, Ferndale., and the other smaller towns within this area.**
- **The Council reserves the right to deviate from the eligibility criteria noted above for good cause, including, but not limited to: the student's family resided in the Eel River Valley Area for at least 5 previous years but moved out of the Area in the 12 months prior to the scholarship application; the family of the student regularly attends our Council Meetings, but lives out of the area.
 - f. Applicants do not need to be related to a member of the Redwood Council, but if they do, they will be awarded one extra point on their score sheet, by each judge.

2. Council obligations:

The council must set the due date for the applications each year. The date must coordinate with the school's presentation of awards, and must give the judges adequate time to do their evaluations.

- a. A committee of at least four members will read and evaluate each applicant in a timely manner. After the applications are evaluated, the committee member will tally up the students scores.
- b. The committee will meet as a group and discuss their evaluation sheets with each other.
- c. The committee will give the council a verbal evaluation of all applicants.
 - i. How did the applicants rank on the evaluating sheets.
 - ii. What are the educational & career goals of all the applicants.
 - iii. The committee will give their recommendations on who should receive the two scholarships to the Council.
 - iv. If the committee deems it justifiable that more than two recipients deserve a scholarship, They must bring the proposal to the Council for consideration.
- d. The committee will prepare certificates to be given to the recipients at their schools award ceremonies.
- e. The committee will select a member or members to present the scholarships to the recipients at their school's awards ceremonies, and at our Installation of Officer's dinner.
- f. The committee will send letters of congratulations to the winning recipients, and letters of support and encouragement to the other applicants.
- g. Publication of notices in church bulletins, and in our local newspapers.
